Principal Responsibilities and Duties:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Direct communication with FIL regarding FIL rules and changing of rules ✓ Ensure rules are enforced nationwide (especially key in relation to National reps having good understanding of FIL rules) ✓ Liaise with Rules and Umpiring Contacts in regions regarding facilitating local training sessions ✓ Develop an umpiring accreditation program which will allow experienced umpires to acknowledge their skill and invite new umpires to better their knowledge. Umpiring sessions should take place bi-annually to allow new umpires to gain accreditation and ensure more experienced umpires are bought up to date
