The Applicant will need to have experience in Managing teams or groups and previous experience and success in tournaments would be beneficial. Former NZ senior players will be given consideration as well.

All applications must be based in New Zealand.

A selection Panel will be made up of the NZWLA High Performance Director, 2 designated NZWLA Executive members or Designates and the Head Coach.

- Manage the overall business and non-coaching functions including all aspects of Squad and Team Camps, Tournaments and Tours;
- Manage the budget for the duration of the program including squad and team preparation;
- Attend all camps, tournaments, and tours through and including 2021 World Championships
- Provide support and maintain positive relationships with all players, coaches, and team support personnel
- Be a member of the Interview panel for the selection of team personnel positions, as required.
- Must maintain communication with the Head Coach, the NZWLA HP Director and where applicable the NZWLA.
